Position: Junior Student Leader Intern (JSLI)

**Description:** A month-long internship experience that teaches leadership, organization, and communication skills in an informal educational setting. Interns will have the opportunity to engage with community leaders, lead group activities, and serve as positive role models for youth grades 5-9 during our one-week Youth Leadership Conference. In preparation for the Conference, interns will participate in various team-building and leadership training activities. This is an unpaid internship opportunity in which interns will gain skills to prepare them for future careers and leadership positions.

\*Internship hours may be used for volunteer/community service hour requirements if approved by your supervising organization.

## **Requirements:**

- Must be a high school student (preferably grades 10-12)
- Must submit the <u>online application</u>
- Must have transportation to and from meetings and engagements
- Have a professional and positive attitude
- Be a self-starter, energetic, and assertive

- Read the JSLI handbook
- Join all webinars
- Complete all JSLI worksheets/forms
- Attend all JSLI trainings
- Arrive timely to all functions
- Attend EVERY DAY of the 5-day Youth Leadership Conference (July 11-15th)
- Co-lead groups of Young Leaders in team-building and leadership exercises
- Assist with presentations regarding leadership and special topics
- Assist with all "field-trips" and off campus events
